
Water Filter Cartridge

The water filter cartridge is located on the right hand side of the ice machine Controls.


The filter cartridge should be replaced every six months when the replacement indicator light turns on or sooner if the flow of water to the ice machine decreases.

Installing the filter Cartridge

1. Remove the water filter from the carton box.
2. Remove the cover from the water filter. Be sure the O-rings are still in place after the cover is removed.




3. Locate the water filter compartment on the right-hand side of the ice machine controls.
4. Align the alignment pin on the side of the filter with the cutout channel in the control housing and insert filter.



5. Turn filter clockwise until it locks into the housing.

NOTE: If the filter is not correctly locked into place, the ice machine will not produce ice.

General Installation/Operation/Maintenance Requirements

- Replace cartridge every six months when the replacement indicator light turns on or sooner if the flow of water to the ice machine decreases.
- Protect from freezing by removing filter cartridge when temperatures are expected to drop below 40°F (4.4°C) . Do not install systems in areas where ambient temperatures may go above 100°F or below 40°F. Do not install on a hot water supply.

Special Notices

- Installation instructions are included with the product when shipped.
- Do not use with water that is microbiologically unsafe or of unknown quality without adequate disinfection before or after the system. Systems certified for cyst reduction may be used on disinfected water that may contain filterable cysts.
- Check for compliance with the applicable state and local laws and regulations.
- Note that while the testing was performed under standard laboratory conditions, actual performance may vary. Systems must be installed and operated in accordance with manufacturer's recommended procedures and guidelines.
- Installation and use MUST comply with all state and local plumbing codes. Do not install if water pressure exceeds 120 psi. If your water pressure exceeds 80 psi (552 kPa), you should install a pressure-limiting valve. Contact a plumbing professional if you are uncertain how to check your water pressure.
- Do not install where water hammer conditions may occur. If water hammer conditions exist you must install a water hammer arrester. Contact a plumbing professional if you are uncertain how to check for this condition.
- When a backflow prevention device is installed on a water system, a device for controlling pressure due to thermal expansion must be installed.

- Replacement of the water filter cartridge due to water pressure that is outside the specified operating range or due to excessive sediment in the water supply.
- Damage to the product caused by accident, fire, floods or acts of God.
- Incidental or consequential damage caused by possible defects with this appliance.

This warranty is extended to the original purchaser and any succeeding owner for products purchased for home or office use within the USA. In Alaska, the warranty excludes the cost of shipping or service to your home or office.
